

- Swap out meat and fish for a plant-based meal one day a week.
- Swap out harmful cleaning chemicals to eco-friendly ones.
- Swap buying one or two new items of clothing for second hand.
- Swap out things made with virgin materials with recycled materials like toilet roll
 or printer paper.
- And don't forget to talk about what you did with others.
